#### Artists of all ages competed for prizes

Every year, the Arts Alliance partners with the Charles County Fair to manage the Fine Arts/Photography exhibit in the P.D. Brown Building during the annual festival. First, the Arts Alliance gathered volunteers on September 7, to stuff 500 Fair Bags full of goodies and promo information received from local organizations. Many thanks to the businesses and organizations who donated items, and to our volunteers for helping to fill the Bags!

Then, on Wednesday, September 12, artists of all ages arrived at the P.D. Brown Building to deliver their art. Hanging began at 8:00 pm, with the judging taking place on Thursday. Cash prizes are given to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place ribbon winners. There were 258 works in the photography category and 154 paintings and drawings for a grand total of 412 works of art this year.

The 82nd Court of Princesses for Queen Nicotina included Mackenzie Shughart, a senior at St. Charles High School, and the Arts Alliance's candidate for Queen. Mackenzie placed 2nd Runner Up in the coronation. Congratulations, Mackenzie!

Again this year in the P.D. Brown Building, the public was invited to vote for the "People's Choice" Award. After hundreds of votes were cast, the winners were: David Boarman, First Place with his drawing of a child; Gordon Johnson, Second Place, with his scenic mountain painting; and Jim McDonald, Third Place with his photo of wildlife.

Special thanks to the many volunteers who helped take in and hang the art, greet visitors, hand out Fair Bags, and assist with returning the art and taking down the exhibit! Check out the photo album on page 4.



#### Solo Artist Show Opens at the Commissioners Gallery







#### Featured Works by Susannah Lynch on Display Through January 16, 2019



I was born in Alexandria, Virginia. My family spent a few years in Venice, California, while my parents finished school, after which we moved to St. Mary's County Maryland. I have lived here ever since.

My art education began with my mother, who was an artist, and encouraged me in artistic pursuits. I attended St. Mary's College of Maryland in St. Mary's City, and graduated in 1987 with a Bachelor's Degree in Art. I was a member of a gallery in the area for a short time after graduation, but family situations made it impossible for me to continue being involved in the gallery, and in art in general. I started working in art, painting and multimedia, again in the early 2000s and since

about 2008 have been working consistently. I have been involved in local art festivals, and regional art exhibitions in Maryland, New York City, and Raleigh, North Carolina. I have also taken workshops to hone my skills in recent years.

My painting and multimedia work is an extension of my own emotional and intellectual life. I experiment with art to fulfill something that cannot be expressed in any other way, such as memories of places, thought and feelings made manifest through tangible means. I strive to engage the viewer emotionally in my work, and hope that viewers bring something of themselves to the work. Light, dark, value contrasts and color all evoke a response of some kind. My goal is to continue to grow, experiment and exist as a painter/creator and to share that experience with others.

I have been interested in art from a very young age. I was raised in Southern Maryland in rural St. Mary's County on a small horse farm. Nature and living things have always inspired me. I live and raised my family in the same town where I grew up. I continue to be inspired by the rural surroundings, and the sweet light that exists between two rivers.
