Meet Keith Linville

Joined the CCAA Board of Directors For FY 2020-2021



Born at Walter Reed Army Medical Center, Keith's family moved to Bryans Road from Oxon Hill in 1972. He attended J.C. Parks Elementary School, Matthew Henson Middle School, and Lackey High School, graduating in 1980. While working full time, Keith attended the Charles County Community College, obtaining an Associate of Arts degree in Computer Programming in 1985. He completed his Bachelor of Science degree in Information Systems Management from the University of Maryland University College in 1991.

Keith retired after 36 years with the Federal Government in September of 2017. For the last 22 years of that time, he worked in the field of Computer Security. Starting with the Naval Sea Logistics Center Atlantic Detachment in Indian Head, from 1995 till 2010, and finishing his last seven years with the AEGIS Training and Readiness Center in Dahlgren, Virginia. In his previous 14 years, he spent time with the U.S.

Post Office as a Rural Relief Carrier, the Federal Bureau of Investigation as a Payroll Distribution Clerk, and the NAVSEA Automated Data Systems Activity in Indian Head as a Computer Programmer.

In the early 2000s, Keith taught the evening Computer Security course at the College of Southern Maryland. In the 90s, Keith volunteered for three years as an Odyssey of the Mind Coach at Mt. Hope Elementary School, and two years as an Appraiser. He has served as an Instant Challenge Appraiser for the last five years for Destination Imagination.

In the summer of 1999, Keith landed his first role in community theater with the Hard Bargain Players (HBP) in Accokeek. In the 20 years since that time, he has performed with the Port Tobacco Players (PTP), HBP, and for six years in the Sotterly Players in the "Sotterley Christmas Past" Holiday Candlelight Tours.



Keith has directed *Don't Drink the Water, The Christmas Schooner, Duck Hunter Shoots Angel, Harvey,* and *The Hound of the Baskervilles* for PTP's main stage. He has Produced and Co-Produced over 20 shows with PTP, most recently *See How They Run, Much Ado About Nothing, Godspell,* and *The Sound of Music.*

Most often Keith serves in a more technical capacity as a Special Effects Designer. In that role, he has received nine Washington Area Theater Community Honors (WATCH) Award Nominations

for Outstanding Special Effects, winning the WATCH Award in 2006.

Keith spent twelve years on the PTP Board of Directors, serving 8 years as the Productions Chair and 2 as the President. Aside from his volunteer work in Theater, Keith is certified as a Maryland Master Naturalist, serving at the American Chestnut Land Trust in Calvert County. In 2019, he has taken part in a Frog and Salamander Population Survey, the Horseshoe Crab Breeding Survey, Parker's Creek Fish Population Study, and a Forest Diversity Study.

Keith, currently, lives in La Plata with his cat, Ethel.

An active member in local community theatre for 50 years, Bill has worked on stage and off as actor, set designer, set construction, graphic artist, and most recently as director. He is also a member of the Board of Directors for the Indian Head Center for the Arts.

CCAA Opens New Exhibit at University of Maryland Charles Regional Medical Center





Addison Likins' Art on Display through January 8, 2020

A resident of Charles County Maryland for over 30 years, Addison has always created art ever since he can remember. Because he was raised in a poverty area in Virginia, he never had access to art education in the public schools, so he wound up being self-taught. He often created art as a teacher, journalist, and later as a designer engineer and analyst, but still had limited access to fine art.



Addison quickly became bored after retiring as a Senior Management Analyst in 2011, and decided to pursue his fine art interest. In the past four years, he has been selected for over 50 juried shows in Maryland, Virginia and the District of Columbia, with selling pieces and earning some prize money. Because Addison is



somewhat color blind, he is limited to photography, which he learned and stud-

ied as a journalist and graduate student at the University of Virginia, and sculpture, a skill that he honed over a ten year span as an exhibit designer.

During the past four years, Addison's fine art work has appeared in and on the cover of the large circulation Mensa Magazine, has had over 75 million views on Google maps. To add to his list of accomplishments, Addison currently works as a part time "stringer" photographer and writer for the Maryland Independent. His art is featured in this show as well as one in the La Plata Town Hall, with more art included in juried shows in Petersburg, Virginia's Walton Galleries, and Dover, Delaware's Bigg's American Art Museum.

Addison currently has individual pieces at the Waldorf West Gallery, The Maryland Federation of Art galleries, the Fredericksburg Center for the Creative Arts, The Anne Marie Arts Center in Dowel Maryland, and the Community Bank of the Chesapeake in both Waldorf and Fredericksburg, Virginia, the Mattawoman Creek Art Center, The Biggs American Art Museum in Dover, Delaware, and the Walton Galleries in Petersburg, Virginia.
